1. This Act may be cited as the Marriage (Amendment) Act, 2023, and shall be read as one with the Marriage Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.	Short title Cap. 50
2. The principal Act is amended in section 2 by the insertion of the following new definition in the appropriate place:	Amendment of section 2

3. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of section 33 and the substitution therefor of the following:	Repeal and replacement of section 33
33. A marriage between persons either of whom is a child, is void.	Void marriage
4. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of section 34 and the substitution therefor of the following:	Repeal and replacement of section 34
34. (1) Nothing contained in this Act shall affect the validity of any marriage contracted under or in accordance with any African customary law, or in any manner apply to marriages so contracted.	Marriage under African Customary law

(3) Any person who is married under this Act or whose marriage is declared by this Act to be valid, shall be incapable, during the continuance of such marriage, of contracting a valid marriage under any African Customary law.
