**An Act to amend the Prohibition of the Development,  
Production, Stockpiling and Use of Chemical Weapons Act.**

[ 12th June, 2026

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Prohibition of the Development, Production, Stockpiling and Use of Chemical Weapons (Amendment) Act, 2026, and shall be read as one with the Prohibition of the Development, Production, Stockpiling and Use of Chemical Weapons Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

(2) This Act shall come into operation on the expiry of the term of office, or removal by the Minister, of the members of the Authority holding office prior to the enactment of this Act, after which the Minister shall appoint the members of the Authority in accordance with this Act.

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by the insertion of the following new definition in the appropriate place in alphabetical order:

“Zambia Revenue Authority” means the Zambia Revenue Authority established under the Zambia Revenue Authority Act.

3. The principal Act is amended in section 5 by the deletion of—

(a) subsections (1) and (2) and the substitution therefor of the following:

(1) The Authority consists of the following part-time members appointed by the Minister:

- (a) the Chairperson, who shall be a representative of the ministry responsible for foreign affairs;
- (b) the Vice-chairperson, who shall be a representative of the ministry responsible for defence;
- (c) a representative of the ministry responsible for health;
- (d) a representative of the Attorney-General;
- (e) a representative of the Zambia Revenue Authority; and
- (f) two persons from the private sector with knowledge and experience in matters relevant to this Act.

(2) The ministries, institutions and organisations referred to in subsection (1) shall nominate their representatives for appointment by the Minister.;

(b) subsection (6) and the substitution therefor of the following:

(6) A member of the Authority shall be paid allowances that the Emoluments Commission may, on the recommendation of the Minister, determine.;

(c) subsection (9) and the substitution therefor of the following:

(9) Five members shall constitute a quorum at a meeting of the Authority.
