An Act to provide for revised salaries for holders of offices to which Article 105 of the Constitution applies; to repeal the Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) Act, 1992; and to provide for matters connected with or incidental to the foregoing.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) Act.

commencement

(2) Section *two* shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st April, 1993.

(3) Section *three* shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st September, 1993.

2. The holder of an office specified in the first column of the Schedule shall be paid a salary at the annual rate prescribed for that office in the second column of the Schedule. Salary
