### An Act to amend the Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) Act

ENACTED	by the Par	liament of	t Zam	o1a.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) (Amendment) Act, 2005, and shall be read as one with Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

Short title and commencement

Cap. 263

- (2) Subject to subsection (3), this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st April, 2005.
  - (3) Part II of the Schedule shall come into effect on 1st April, 2006.
- 2. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of section two and 10 the substitution therefor of the following:

Repeal and replacement of section 2

2. There shall be paid to the holder of an office specified in the first column of the Schedule, in accordance with the dates specified in Part I and Part II of the ScheduleSalary and responsibility allowance

- (a) a salary at the annual rate prescribed for that office in the second column of the Schedule; and
- (b) a responsibility allowance at the annual rate prescribed for that office in the third column of the Schedule.
- 3. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of the Schedule and 20 the substitution therefor of the Schedule set out in the Appendix to this Act.

Repeal of Part 1 of Schedule

4. For the avoidance of doubt, Part I of the Schedule shall stand repealed on 1st April, 2006.
