A BILL

ENTITLED

An Act to amend the Public-Private Partnership Act, 2023.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Public-Private Partnership (Amendment) Act, 2026, and shall be read as one with the Public Private Partnership Act, 2023, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

Short title and commencement

5 (2) This Act shall come into operation on the expiry of the term of office, or removal by the President, of the members of the Council holding office prior to the enactment of this Act, after which the President shall appoint the members of the Council in accordance with this Act.

10 2. Section 7(1) of the principal Act is amended by the deletion of paragraphs (c) and (d) and the substitution therefor of the following:

Amendment of section 7

(c) two other Ministers, whose portfolio functions are relevant to public-private partnerships;; and

15 (d) five other persons from the private sector with proven knowledge and experience in matters relating to public-private partnerships.
