# A BILL

ENTITLED

## **An Act to amend the Higher Education Act.**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Higher Education (Amendment) Act, 2026, and shall be read as one with the Higher Education Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

5 (2) This Act shall come into operation on the expiry of the term of office, or removal by the Minister, of the members of the Board holding office prior to the enactment of this Act, after which the Minister shall appoint the members of the Board in accordance with this Act

10 2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by the insertion of the following new definitions in the appropriate places in alphabetical order:

“Emoluments Commission” means the Emoluments Commission established under the Constitution;

15 “Examinations Council of Zambia” means the Examinations Council of Zambia established under the Examinations Council of Zambia Act, 2023.

- Cap.138 “Technical Education, Vocational and Entrepreneurship Training Authority” means the Technical Education, Vocational and Entrepreneurship Training Authority established under the Technical Education, Vocational and Entrepreneurship Training Act; 5
- Cap. 390 “Zambia Institute of Chartered Accountants” means the Zambia Institute of Chartered Accountants established under the Accountants Act; and
- Act No. 3 of 2022 “Zambia Institute of Human Resources Management” means the Zambia Institute of Human Resource Management established under the Zambia Institute of Human Resource Management Act, 2022. 10
- Amendment of section 7 **3.** Section 7 of the principal Act is amended by the deletion of—
- (a) subsection (1) and the substitution therefor of the following: 15
- (1) There is constituted the Board of the Authority which consists of the following part time members appointed by the Minister:
- (a) a representative of the ministry responsible for higher education; 20
  - (b) a representative of the Attorney General;
  - (c) a representative of the Zambia Institute of Chartered Accountants; 25
  - (d) a representative of the Examinations Council of Zambia;
  - (e) a representative of the Zambia Institute of Human Resource Management;
  - (f) a representative of the Technical Education, Vocational and Entrepreneurship Training Authority; 30
  - (g) a representative of the Zambia Chamber of Commerce and Industry;
  - (h) a representative of a civil society organisation working in the education sector; and 35

(i) one person from the private sector with knowledge and experience in matters relating to higher education.; and

5 (b) subsection (5) and the substitution therefor of the following:

(5) The ministries, institutions and organisations referred to in subsection (1) shall nominate their representatives for appointment by the Minister.

4. The First Schedule to the principal Act is amended—

10 (a) in paragraph 1(4), by the deletion of the word “Six” and the substitution therefor of the word “Five”; and

15 3. A member of the Board or a committee of the Board shall be paid allowances that the Emoluments Commission may, on the recommendation of the Minister, determine.
