A BILL

ENTITLED

An Act to amend the Betting Control Act.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Betting Control Short title (Amendment) Act, 2021, and shall be read as one with the Betting Cap.166 Control Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

(2) This Act shall come into operation on 1st January, 2022.

2. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of section 14 and the substitution therefor of the following:

- 14. (1) A bookmaker licensed under this Act shall pay, at the time of the first issue of a licence, a fee of five hundred thousand fee units, and two hundred and fifty thousand fee units for each renewal of that licence.
- (2) A licence issued under subsection (1) shall be valid for License Fee a period of one year.
