AMENDMENT BILL, 2022**

MEMORANDUM

The object of this Bill is to amend the Judges (Conditions of Service). Act so as to provide for the determination of emoluments of judges by the Emoluments commission.

A BILL

ENTITLED

An Act to amend the Judges (Conditions of Service) Act.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. This Act may be cited as the Judges (Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Act, 2022, and shall be read as one with the Judges (Conditions of Service) Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

Short title

Cap. 277

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by the —
(a) deletion of the definition of “emoluments” and the substitution therefor of the following:

Amendment of section 2

“emoluments” has the meaning assigned to the word in the Constitution;;and

Cap. 1

(b) insertion of the following new definition in the appropriate place in alphabetical order:

“Emoluments Commission” means the Emoluments Commission established by the Constitution;.

3. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of section 3 and the substitution therefor of the following:

Repeal and replacement of section 3

3. There is paid to a Judge emoluments that the Emoluments Commission shall, on the recommendation of the President, determine.

4. Section 12(2) of the principal Act is amended by the insertion of the words “in consultation with the Emoluments Commission,” immediately after the word “may,”.
